

Bachelor students may earn a Bachelor degree in Theology or Ministry. The degree may have an emphasis in any of the following: Pastoral, Counseling, Missions and Evangelism, Youth Counseling or Worship Leadership.

The student must have a degree in Biblical Studies or the equivalent of 60 hours of lower division courses or ministry experience. An AA degree from an accredited college is admissible, (Christian or secular). Send in your application and a copy of your transcripts for evaluation. If you have extensive credits or ministry experience you may qualify for the Bachelor of Theology concurrent program.

Fifteen courses are required for a Bachelor's Degree in Theology. A Practicum is required if you have no ministry experience or if you desire a Bachelor of Ministry designation. Practicums are real work experience in a ministry under the authority of a bona fide ministry leader in your home town.

Note: We suggest no more than 2 classes for students who are working full time. Classes are offered during their respective quarters, only.
