**Final Exam -Due 1 week from final day of class.**

Read and review the forms on the pages after 365 in the book. Include any parts of this type of information as if you have a background on an interviewee. In other words, pretend that you know the background of the client, as you complete the following.

Write 3-5 pages typed double spaced 10-12 font in Ariel or Times Roman, 1" borders. Write on the following: Do an interview progressing through one of the strongholds listed in Chapters 10-15. In your session with a counselee make sure that you are progressing as if you were a Discipleship Counselor as outlined in the book. Your interview will be in the form of a dialog such as:

Counselor: Hello, Robert, I am John Smith.

Robert: **Yes, I came by because Mary Richards recommended that I speak to you about my life and problems.**

Counselor: Well, good, I would be happy to speak with you, and with God's help we will be able to work through these issues. Do you know how I operate?

Robert: **Well, I am not sure but I know Mary said you are a Christian.**

Counselor: Yes, that's correct. I use scripture in my interview process and I do pray before, during and after our sessions so that I can be in tune with God as well as ask for His power to move in our sessions and in our lives.

How's your spiritual life?

Robert: **I don't know, it's ok, I guess.**

Counselor: Well, I will begin with prayer and then I would like to ask you about that further. Is that ok?

Robert: **Sure.**

Counselor: Lord, ....etc...
